To Whom It May Concern:

This is to confirm that the Crohn's & Colitis Foundation of America, Inc. (CCFA) is a 501[c]3 not-for-profit organization organized under the laws of New York State. We currently operate approximately 33 staffed chapters throughout the United States, and file consolidated financial and tax reports.

This is to confirm that each Chapter of CCFA, including the Fairfield/Westchester Chapter located in White Plains, NY is a fully chartered, subordinate chapter of the CCFA organization, whose financial information is consolidated with all other CCFA chapters and the National Organization for all mandated reporting purposes. The Fairfield/Westchester Chapter is a subordinate in good standing with the parent organization.

CCFA's exemption status is filed on an "individual" basis...that is that CCFA is considered one entity by the IRS. Group filings are done when each chapter uses a separate and different tax ID, which CCFA does not. Accordingly, the IRS will not issue a "group" ruling letter for CCFA since CCFA files on an individual basis. CCFA's Chapters use the same EIN as the National organization.

Accordingly, this letter is to certify that each Chapter of CCFA (as do all CCFA Chapters throughout the United States) utilizes the same Tax Identification number for all purposes, which is: 13-6193105. Please contact me if there is any additional information required.
